## An Author in our Midst

Many of you will be familiar with Rev. Dr. Roy Long, who is a member of our congregation, and may have enjoyed his excellent preaching when he has been with us for worship. Since his 'retirement' from active ministry in the Lutheran Church, he has given much of his time to his writing, and recently has had two books published.

The first, entitled "Martin Luther and his Legacy", published by the Council of Lutheran Churches, (Pastor Sarah Farrow would be able to let you have copy- ask Pastor Libby for details) and the second, which as a British Lutheran I found particularly interesting, is called, "Saints, Sinners and Martyrs", telling the story of a variety of historical figures and their involvement in what Pastor Long calls, "..... early sixteenth century reformations in Britain".
